A French savant, Professor Deville, has lately submitted to the Academy of Sciences in Paris an essay on the cause of petroleum explosions and consequent conflagrations. He finds the cause, not in the greater inflammability of the oil, but in the great expansion of volume under the influence of a higher temperature. Barrels filled with the oil in the winter season either burst or crack that the oil may flow out as soon as the warm weather sets in. The oil thus freed evaporates a highly inflammable gas, which takes fire at the touch of the smallest spark. He therefore advises that all oil should be shipped or stored in casks but partially filled giving it room to expand in the higher temperature of the warmer seasons.
