buy for balance of month. No sales of im-
portance. Late 1000 cars sold 41. Phila-

lots, sold very steady, prices were observed,
sales 1000 bbls refined standard white Nov.
delivery at 36 and 4000 bbls ditto Dec. de-
livery 35.
