NEWS ITEMS

The argument in the Bible case at Cincinnati is closed. The decision will be rendered in a few days.

Captain Ben Ester, who was committed at Chicago for killing the desperado Pfeiffer, has been discharged.

A boiler at the Sheller mine, near Mine Hill, N. J., exploded yesterday. Engineer Reynolds was scalded to death.

G. Couder, formerly of Keyport, N. J., was found on Wednesday on the roadside, bruised so badly that he has since died. Investigation leads to the belief that he was murdered. There is no clue to the murderers.

Charles Vanduzen, a wealthy citizen, donates \$50,000 to form a vigilance committee to rid New York of thieves and murderers, the committee to be organized in January.

A petition signed by 23,749 citizens of Philadelphia, for the recognition of the Republic of Cuba, has reached Washington, and will be presented to Congress immediately.

James H. Brown, one of the murderers in Cleveland for the murder of his wife in Berea, Ohio, some months since, has been convicted of murder in the first degree.

A letter from Madrid reports the progress of Minister Sabin's Cuba diplomacy, with the members of the Spanish Cabinet to Nov. 7th. Native prejudices were being dispelled rapidly, and the question of the sale and transfer of the island was talked over quietly during the recess of a very pleasant ministerial session.

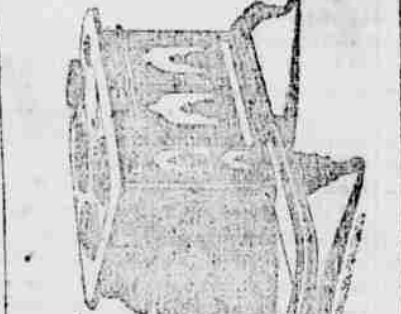
