The Secretary of the Tensury has been or some time, perplexed by the ingenuity of counterfeiters in Imitating the national currency. The Superintendent of the Note urday. Printing Bureau has suggested the following plan: To devise plates with very few lines and the plainest kind of engraving, so that the mercest novice can become familiar with their appearance in a very brief space; to print the notes from these plates on light colored paper of a peculiar quality, and then let the counterfeiters go to work. The idea is that the least variation in the quality or appearance of the paper or in the engraving may then be at once discovered: and the moment a counterfait makes its anpearance all notes of the denomination thus imitated can be called in at once, when the Treasury may immediately issue another plate.
