The market is quiet and dull, no sales to report. Buyers are offering \$4.35 to \$4.40 while sellers are firm at \$4.50 to \$4.60.

Reports of all the Sales of Petroleum in New York Yesterday.
Crude in bulk easier market for buyers, few small lots been taken by refiners footing 1400 bbls part 15% balance private arms, crude shipping order dull at 20% @ 20%, sales 5000 bbls private prices. Refined scarcely any inquiry, one or two small lots been taken by shippers to fill vessels but very unsettled tone to market, principally through influence of lower gold and irregular exchange market, no speculative inquiry, sales 1000 bbls S. W. 29% and 5000 bbls high test 29%, case oil inquired for, sales 1500 cases 26%. Philadelphia delivery prices drooped, still further unsettled feeling, scarcely any desire to negotiate ahead, sales 5000 bbls refined S. W. high test 27% 2000 bbls for Feb. 28; 1500 bbls for march 28% and settlement of contracts of 1500 bbls from March to May reported 29%.
