**SECOND DAY.**

No. 3.—Purse \$1,175. Poo for all horses. \$600 to the first, \$600 to the second, \$175 to the third and \$100 to the fourth.

No. 4.—Purse \$400 for horses that have never beaten 2:41. \$250 to the first, \$100 to the second and \$50 to the third.

All the above races are mile heats, best three in five, in harness, and will be conducted under the rules of the National Association for the promotion of the interests of the American trotting turf. A horse distorting the field shall only be entitled to the first premium.
