



Note.—The passage referred to by Judge Grier in his former decision, 3 Wallace, p. 209 adopted as applicable to this case was as follows:

"It is usually the case, when any valuable discovery is made, or any new machine of great utility is invented, that the attention of the public has been turned to that subject previously, and that many persons have been making researches and experiments. Philosophers and mechanicians may have measure anticipated in their speculations the possibility or pronachiny of such discovery or invention; many experiments have been successfully titled, couling very near, yet failing short of the desired result. They have produced nobling beneficial. The invention whe perfected may truly be said to be the ethiniating point of many experiments, not only by the inventor, but by many others, it is may have profited indirectly by the measuressful experiments and fallures of others, but it gives them no right to cas me a share of the henor of the profit of the successful inventor.
