OPINION OF JUDGE GRIER.
As I write this I can only state the conclusions to which my mind has come after a careful examination of this case.

The court has exhibited a patent dated 25th of April, 1890. This is prima facie evidence of a good title, and puts on the respondents the burden of proof that the patent is void or worthless.

I need not repeat my remarks in the case of Goodson vs. Day, (2 Wall, C. C. Rep. 529), but now adopt them as affording a rule of decision which applies clearly to the present case.

CAUTION.
The public is cautioned against employing any of the regular authorized agents of the Company, since the Roberts' Patent covers the use of the Torpedoes and all explosive materials for oil wells, and the use of such materials by other parties is a direct infringement of their rights. Any parties infringing any of the ROBERTS' PATENTS will be held to account according to law, and as acting willfully and knowingly in defiance of law and the doctrine of the courts.
