Another Valuable Invention.

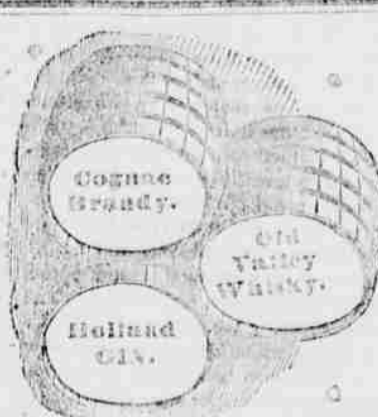
