THE LAWRENCE.—There is a project on foot for raising the wreck of Commodore Perry's flag ship, the Lawrence, and cutting her timbers up into souvenirs, such as canes, work boxes, dressing cases, etc. The Lawrence has been sunk in Misery Bay since the time she was towed into this port, immediately after the famous battle with and victory over the British fleet, sixty years ago. The timbers are "water seasoned," most of the fibress of a greenish black or very dark brown color, and capable of a polish as fine as mahogany. A great many "Lawrence canes" have been made, at different times, from pieces of the wreck, and are prized on account of the historic association connected therewith. The wreck is owned by the City Treasurer, Mr. Leander Dobbin, who purchased it from the government several years ago.—[Erie Dispatch.
