Thanksgiving Proclamation.

WASHINGTON, Oct. 11.
By the President of the United States of
America, a Proclamation.
Whereas, The revolution of another year
has again brought the time when it is usual
to look back upon the past, and publicly
thank the Almighty for his mercies and his
blessings, and
Whereas, If any one people has more oc-
casion than another for just thankfulness, it
is the citizens of the United States, whose
Government is their creature, subject to
their best interests; who have resorted to them-
selves ample civil and religious freedom
and equality before the law; who, during
the last twelve months have enjoyed exemp-
tions from any grievances or general calam-
ities; and to whom prosperity in Agriculture,
manufacture and commerce has been vouch-
safed.
Therefore, by these considerations, I re-
commend that on Thursday, the 28th day
of November next, the people meet in their
respective places of worship and there make
their acknowledgments to God for his kind-
ness and bounty.
In witness whereof I here unto set my
hand and caused the seal of the United
States to be affixed.
Done at the city of Washington, this 11th
day of October, in the year of our Lord
1872, and of the independence of the
United States the ninety-seventh.
Signed U. S. GRANT,
