The oil market remains firm at this point at \$4.50@4.60, with not much doing. 1,000 barrels for local refiners sold at \$4.50.

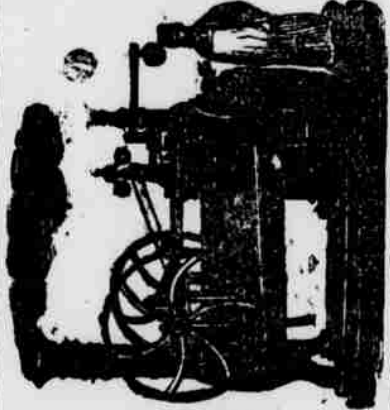
