GRAND GIFT CONCERT!

Postponed to December 7, 1872.

THE SECOND GRAND GIFT CONCERT in aid of the PUBLIC LIBRARY OF KENTUCKY, announced for September 28, has been postponed to DECEMBER 7, 1872, because the accumulation of orders the few days before the drawing made it physically impossible to fill them. Without a few days' delay, but as a short postponement was inevitable, it was determined to do it a time that would make a full drawing sure by the sale of all the tickets.

The money necessary to pay in full all the tickets is now upon deposit in the Farmers' and Drivers' Bank, as will be seen by the following certificate of the Cashier and Drivers' Bank, Louisville, Ky., Sept. 26, 1872.

This is to certify that there is now on deposit in this bank over half a million of dollars to the credit of the Gift Concert fund, \$500,000 of which is held by this bank as Treasurer of the Public Library of Kentucky to pay off all gifts to be awarded at the drawing.

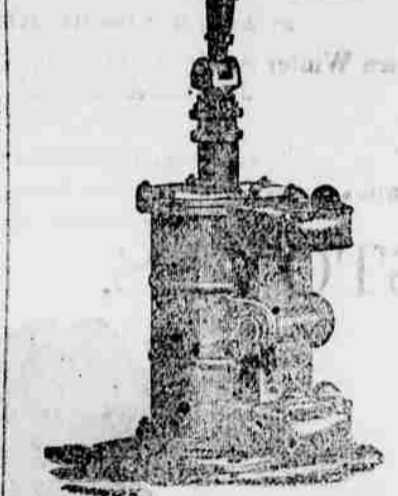
