\$500,000 in Bank.

GRAND 6 FT CONCERT Postponed to December 7, 1872

THE SECOND GRAND GUT CONCERT in aid of the PUBLIC LIBRARY OF KENTUCKY, announced for November 28, has been postponed to December 7, 1872, because the arena is not yet ready for the use of the Library of Kentucky. It was determined to give a time to make a full drawing care by the sale of all tickets. The money necessary to pay in full all the offered tickets, now upon deposit in the Treasury, and for the balance to be seen by the following certificate of the Auditor and Director of Bank, Louisville, Ky., dated 25 1872. This is to certify that on deposit in the Treasury over half a million of dollars in the form of the Grand Gut Concert, \$500,000 of which is held in the bank as a guarantee of the Library of Kentucky to pay off all gifts to be announced at the drawing.

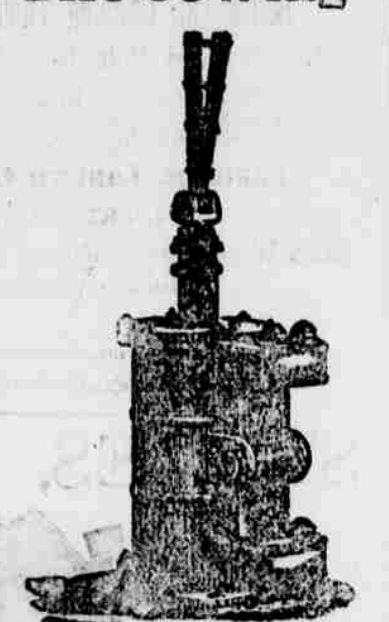
