THE TORPEDO PATENT SUITS Roberts vs. Nicholas Geyer.

The following is the decision rendered by Judge McKenuan, at May Term of the Circuit Court in the

in the Circuit Court of the United States, in and for the Western District of Pennsylvania.—E. A. L. Roberts vs. Nicholas Geyer.—No. 1.—May Term

November 21, 1872. Bill filed and subports is

December 13, 1872. Metion for preliminary in-unction heard, and the Court being duly navised in the premises; the injunction awarded as prayed for

June 2d, 1873. Hule for attachment in this case

came on to be heard, and after argument of counsel pro and con, the Court being full advised in the premises, the Rule is made absolute, and the sentence of the Court is, that the said defendan, Nicholas Goyer, be impriosened in the common Jail of Allegeony County for and during the term of ten days, and that he pay the costs of this proceed.

The act of infringement for which the defendent was committed for contempt, consisted in aiding Alexandra Hamar in exploding torpedoes in of wells being the same act of infringement for which Hamar was also committed in the case No. 3, No. vember Term, 1866, as before stated.

The Court McKennan, J., after delivering his pointon in the Hamar case, proceeded to sentence Nicholas Goyer for contempt, and delivered the fel

owing oral opinion:

Lin the case of Nicholas Geyer charged with the same offense, I am entirely satisfied that there was fluid present, in the Beats well at least. As I have intimated to the counsel in the course of the argu ment, the presence of fluid in the well, whether de-nired or not, is an infringement of the patent, and a breach of the injunction of the Court.

Mr Roberts, by his patent uses as one of the prin cipal elements of his invention fluid tamping, and wherever there is fluid sufficient in a well, at the time of the explosion of a torpedo, to operate as tamping, whether it gets there naturally or is put there artificially, his patent is infringed. This was

clearly the case in regard to the Boals well.

But Mr. Geyer seems to have been misled by Hamar, who told him that he merely wanted to make an experiment and I do not think. this being the first time, that he ought to be very severely punished.

punished.

He also is adjudged guilty of contempt and ordered to pay the costs of this proceeding and undergo an imprisonment in the county jail for ten days.—
I bope this will be the last of these cases; because, if the matter comes to our notice agian, we will be constrained to impose such panishment as will tend to make the decree of the Court effectual.
