TORPEDO PATENT SUITS Roberts vs. Nicholas Geyer.

The following is the decision rendered;by Judge McKennan, at May Term of the Circuit Court in the above case:

in the Circuit Court of the United States, in and for the Western District of Pennsylvania.—E. A L. Roberts vs. Nicholas Geyer.—No. 1.—May Term 1873.—In Equity

November 21, 1872. Bill filed and subposts is

December 13, 1872. Motion for preliminar injunction heard, and the Court being duly advised in the premises; the injunction awarded as prayed for, and decree filed.

The injunction in this case was for infringement of the Roberts' patent of No.--(called the Big Patent), for increasing the productiveness of oil wells. The net of infringement for which the defendent The act of infringement for which the settingent was committed for contempt, consisted in siding Alexandra Hamar in exploding torpedoes in of wells being the same act of intringement for which Hamar was also committed in the case No. 3, No. ember Term, 1866, as before stated.

The Court McKennan, J., after delivering his opinion in the Hamar case, proceeded to sentence Nicholas Geyer for contempt, and delivered the fet-

owing oral opinion: L.In the case of Nicholas Geyer charged with the same offense, I am entirely satisfied that there was field present, in the Bears well at least. As I have intimated to the coursel in the course of the argument, the presence of fluid in the well, whether de-circle or wel, is an infringement of the patent, and a breach of the injunction of the Court.

Mr Hoberts, by his patent uses as one of the principal elements of his invention fluid tamping, and wherever there is faid sufficient in a well, at the time of the explosion of a torpedo, to operate as tamping, whether it gets there naturally or is put there artificially, his patent is infringed. This was clearly the case in regard to the Bouls well.

But Mr. Geyer seems to have been misled by Hamar, who told him that he merely wanted to make an experiment; and I do not think, this being the first time, that he ought to be very severely punished.

ing the first principle of contempt and order-punished. He also is adjudged guilty of contempt and undergo at imprisonment in the county fall for ten days— I hope this will be the last of these cases; because, if the matter comes to our notice agian, we will be constrained to impose such panishment as will tend to make the decree of the Court effectual.
