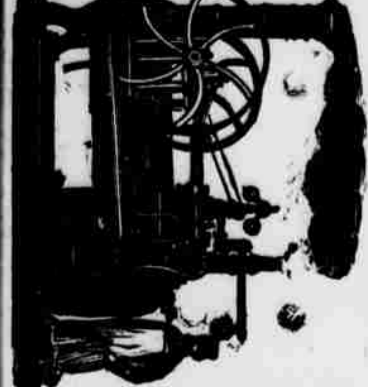

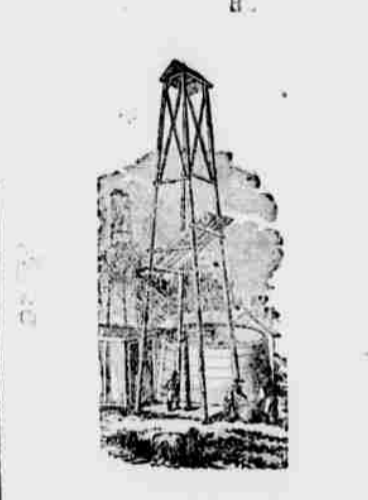
The oil market shows a falling off of 10
