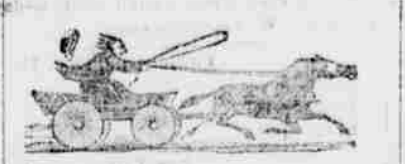

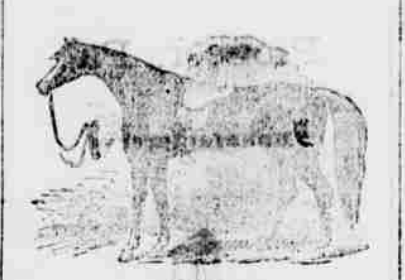

**THE TORPEDO PATENT SUIT**

**Roberts vs. Nicholas Geyer**  
 The following is the decision rendered by Judge McKean, at May Term of the Circuit Court in above case:  
 In the Circuit Court of the United States, in and for the Western District of Pennsylvania.—E. A. Roberts vs. Nicholas Geyer.—No. 1.—May Term 1872.—In Equity.  
 November 21, 1872. Bill filed and subject matter.  
 Subpoena and notice of application for preliminary injunction served.  
 December 14, 1872. Motion for preliminary injunction heard, and the Court being duly advised, the preliminary injunction awarded as prayed for and dissolved.  
 January 14, 1873. Injunction issued, and on 25th day of January judgment served personal and by copy.  
 May 21, 1873. Issue joined for defendant to show cause why attachment should not issue for restraining defendant's execution and daily work.  
 June 21, 1873. Return of attachment in this cause made on to be heard, and after argument of counsel on and on, the Court being fully advised in premises, the Rule is made absolute, and the sense of the Court is, that the said defendant, Nicholas Geyer, be imprisoned in the common jail of Allegheny County for and during the term of six months, and that he pay the costs of this proceeding.  
 June 24, 1873. Committee on 4.  
 The injunction in this case was for restraining of the Roberts' patent of No. 1, called the "torpedo," for their using the productiveness of all the means of infringement for which the defendant was committed for contempt, consisted in using Alexander Haer in expelling torpedoes from wells being the same act of infringement for which Haer was also committed in the case No. 2, in former Term, 1866, as before stated.  
 The Court McKean, J. after collecting the opinion in the Haer case, proceeded to sustain Nicholas Geyer for contempt, and delivered the following opinion:  
 In the case of Nicholas Geyer charged with contempt, I am entirely satisfied that there is no ground for the injunction in this case, and that the presence of fluid in the well, whether it be oil or not, is an infringement of the patent, and each of the injunction of the Court.  
 Mr. Roberts, by his patent uses as one of the principal elements of his invention fluid trapped, and wherever there is fluid sufficient in a well, at the time of the explosion of a torpedo, to operate the torpedo, whether it gets there naturally or is there artificially, his patent is infringed. This is the case in regard to the wells in this case. Mr. Geyer seems to have been misled by a friend, who told him that he merely used a torpedo in an experiment and I do not think, he is the first time, that he ought to be very much surprised.  
 He who is adjudged guilty of contempt and held to pay the costs of this proceeding, and where judgment in the county jail for ten days, and he will be the last of the case, because the Court cannot see how it can be so as to be so much to improve such proceedings as will make the decree of the Court effectual.
