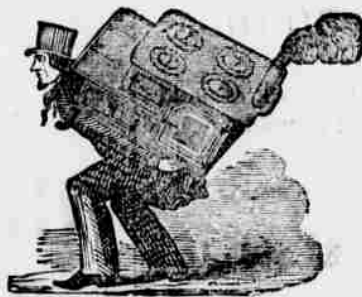

THE

TORPEDO PATENT SUIT

Roberts vs. Nicholas Geyer

The following is the decision rendered by the Court in the above case:

In the Circuit Court of the United States, in and for the Western District of Pennsylvania, in the case of Roberts vs. Nicholas Geyer, No. 1—May Term, 1874.—In Equity

November 21, 1874. Bill filed and returned. Subpoena and notice of application for preliminary injunction served.

December 13, 1874. Motion for preliminary injunction heard, and the Court being only advised of the premises, the injunction awarded as prayed and decreed.

January 14, 1875. Injunction issued, and on 20th day of January indictment served personally and by copy.

May 22, 1875. Rule issued for the defendant to come why attachment should not issue for violation of injunction and duty served.

June 24, 1875. Rule for attachment in this case on to be heard, and after argument of counsel pro and con, the Court being fully advised of the premises, the rule is made absolute, and the defendant, Nicholas Geyer, be imprisoned in the common jail of Allegheny County for and during the term of Geyer, and that he pay the costs of this proceeding.

June 24, 1875. Commitment issued.

The injunction in this case was for infringement of the Roberts' patent of No. — (entitled the Buoyant), for increasing the productivity of oil wells. The act of infringement for which the defendant, Nicholas Geyer, was committed, consisted in causing Alexander Hamar to expel torpedoes from wells being the same act of infringement for which Hamar was also committed in the case No. —, November Term, 1869, as before stated.

The Court McKean, J., a fortiori, in his opinion in the Hamar case, proceeded to hold that Nicholas Geyer for contempt, and delivered the following oral opinion:

In the case of Nicholas Geyer, charged with same offense, I am entirely satisfied that there is fluid present in the Buoyant well at least, as intended to be caused in the course of the experiment, the presence of fluid in the well, whether it is an infringement of the patent, or not, is an infringement of the patent, and is such of the infringement of the Court.

Mr. Roberts, by his patent uses as one of the principal elements of his invention fluid, tampered wherever there is fluid sufficient in a well, as time of the explosion of a torpedo, to operate tampering, whether it is there naturally or is there artificially, his patent is infringed. It is clearly the case in regard to the Buoyant well, that Mr. Geyer seems to have been misled by Hamar, who told him that he merely wanted to make an experiment; and I do not think, during the first time, that he ought to be very severely punished.

He also is adjudged guilty of contempt and is to pay the costs of this proceeding, and is to be imprisoned in the county jail for ten days, if he does not pay the costs of this proceeding, and if the matter comes to our notice again, I will be constrained to impose such punishment as will make the decree of the Court effectual.
