LATE SOUTHERN GLEANINGS.

From late files of Southern papers received at the BULLETIN office, we extract the following items: The appropriations passed by the rebel Congress for the support of the government for the year ending June 30th, 1864, include some curious items, among them the following: Salary of the President of the Confederate States, \$12,500; salary of the Vice-President, \$4,000; expenses incurred in the logging and transportation of coal belonging to New Orleans banks, \$550; transportation of troops and stores, and purchase of animals and stores, by the Quartermaster's Department, \$70,000,446; subsistence of money and supplies for the same, \$1,000,000; nitre and mining service, \$9,500,000; construction of iron-clads in the Confederate States, \$3,000,000; construction of submarine batteries, \$100,000; support of Marine Corps, \$100,000; support of four steam cruisers in the Confederate States of the class of the Alabama and Florida, \$2,500,000; armament of Governor and other officers of Carolina Territory, \$4,000,000; amount required to comply with stipulations entered into between the Confederate States and certain Indian tribes, \$182,000,000. The total appropriation amounts to \$478,858,955.00.
