

CONDITION OF PENNSYLVANIA RAILROADS.

Annual Report to the Legislature.

HARRISBURG, Feb. 27, 1886.—The condition of the railroads in Pennsylvania is set forth in an annual report of the Auditor General, now ready to be made to the Legislature. The following statistics for the year 1885, are from advance sheets of the report:

Freight carried includes 400,050 tons of petroleum, 2,843,858 tons of bituminous coal, and 11,391,477 tons of anthracite coal; also, 570,881 tons of iron ore, 1,194,988 tons of agricultural products, and 791,564 tons of merchandise.
