

Pennsylvania Legislature. HARRISBURG, March 12. SENATE.—The Senate was not in session today.

HOUSE.—The House met at 7 1/2 P. M. The Governor's message was received, voting the act allowing the Philadelphia and Erie Railroad to build branches.

Mr. Riddiman moved the discharge of the Committee on Roads and Bridges from the consideration of the opening certain streets through the Kensington depot, and he stated that the Judiciary Committee already had a similar bill under consideration.

The motion to discharge was not agreed to. Mr. Glass offered a resolution for a final adjournment on the 12th of April, which passed.

The following petitions were presented: One by Mr. De Haven, from 180 citizens, favoring the incorporation of the Society of Progressive Spiritualists.

Mr. Wainwright presented a bill in favor of a free bridge at South Street, Schuylkill. The following bills were introduced.

One by Mr. Davis, incorporating the Crescon Library. Mr. Hood, one appointing two additional notaries public.

Mr. Marks, one allowing the Baptist Institute to sell real estate in the Twenty-fourth Ward.

Mr. J. T. Thomas presented a bill exempting the Lincoln Institute from taxation. Mr. Riddiman, a bill allowing the Sixth Street Railroad to lay a track on Minor street.

Mr. Hosack, a bill for the relief of citizens of Adams county for damages sustained during the war.

Mr. Negley presented a bill incorporating the Farmers Land Improvement Company. Mr. Tyson, a bill authorizing the city of Chester to erect water works.

Mr. Gushkin, a bill incorporating the City Cottage Company. (See supplement to the Frankford and Holmesburg Railroad.)
