From Washington. (Special Despatch to the Bulletin.) WASHINGTON, March 22.—It is asserted to-day by those high in the confidence of the President, that he has already prepared his veto for the Civil Rights bill, and that it may be expected at any moment. He takes the same ground as in his veto of the Freedmen's bill, that all legislation for Southern States in which they have no participation is unconstitutional. The Ways and Means Committee have just adjourned, without coming to any conclusion in regard to the Loan bill question. The subject will be resumed again to-morrow. The bill to facilitate commerce between States was considered by the Senate Commerce Committee, to-day. The committee are said to favor the scheme.
