

Canada and the Fenians. TORONTO, Nov. 8.—The Leader of to-day editorially says the indications in the case of the condemned Fenians look towards leniency.

The Globe has despatches from Montreal, saying it is understood that the Government, at a late Cabinet meeting, resolved to commute the sentence of Lynch and McWhorter.

Three men, named Bell, Flanagan and Wells, confined in the old jail since June 1st, on a charge of Fenianism, were released from custody by the Grand Jury having ignored the bills against them.
