MISCHIEVOUS BOYS—POLICEMAN ASSAULTED AND MAN SHOT.—Last evening, Officer Wilcox, a gentleman notified about eight o'clock, that some boys had stretched across the sidewalk at Thirty-seventh and Lancaster avenue a wire by which passengers were thrown down. He alleges that about three weeks ago Mulholland eloped with Mrs. Maloney, the latter leaving her children behind to be taken care of by the father. Previous to the departure of the train, Mr. Maloney further avers, the furniture in the house was sold for \$150, and \$575 in money, which he had saved from his earnings, were abstracted. The proceeds of the sale and the stolen money were all taken by the runaway pair. Mrs. Maloney has not yet been captured. Mulholland was committed for a further hearing.

FINANCE AND BUSINESS—NOV. 19, 1866. A further decline of one per cent, in gold has increased the depression which has existed for many days past both in stocks and merchandise, and the transactions to-day were of an extremely limited character.

Government Loans were lower, 118 was the best bid for the Compo Sixes, '91; 108 1/2 for the Five Twenties, and 105 1/2 for the Sixes. The Seven-Thirties were nominal, and were fully 1/2 per cent. lower. State Loans were very dull. City Loans closed 102 1/2 bid for the new, and 98 for the old issues. Reading Railroad was fraction higher, and closed at 86 1/2; Catwissa Railroad Preferred was strong at 23 1/2; bid for Camden and Amboy Railroad, 125 for Philadelphia and Trenton Railroad, 94 1/2 for Pennsylvania Railroad, 57 1/2 for Little Schuylkill Railroad, 23 for Germantown Railroad and 22 for Philadelphia and Erie Railroad. Canal stocks were quiet. Schuylkill Navigation Preferred closed 85 1/2 bid; the Common Stock at 85 1/2; Morris Canal at 45, and Delaware Division at 47. Bank shares were without notable change. The flour market is very quiet and buyers are holding off for some concession in price. There is no bidding demand and only a few hundred barrels were taken by the home consumers at \$10.00 per bushel, including 100 barrels fancy at \$11.75, Penna. and Ohio family at \$11.25, fancy lots at \$10.25, extras at \$9.00 and \$8.00. Corn is dull and quiet, in quality. The wheat market is extremely quiet and in the absence of sales we quote Red at \$1.35 to \$1.40 per bushel for Pennsylvania, and \$1.30 to \$1.35 for Ohio.
