

NEW PUBLICATIONS.

The Journal of the Franklin Institute, for July, July, with four pages of "Items and Novelties" which brings the reader into contact with the latest inventions of the year. In the department of Civil Engineering we have the construction of "Chicago's" account of Pneumatic Bridge Foundry, with plates representing a bridge over the Niemen, and two views of the bridge on the Rhine at Kehl, and an account to the Rockwell article on the Storz canal. Then follow a description of the Comenian pumping-engine, noted for its economy of fuel; the construction of Mr. Hodge's centrifugal engine, or "Featuring a Principle"; "Nitro-Glycerine as an Industrial Agent," by John Mayer; the continuation of "The Matter," by the Editor of the Physics, and the commencement, with cuts, of a description of the Gifford Injector. The most readable article is the photographic report of Prof. Mott's second lecture, called "Sunlight and Moonlight," illustrated with a picture after Hamilton of the surface of Copernicus, as seen by the light of Venus, which are continued. The "High Notes" from the Franklin Institute building, drawing, etc.

"C. D." continues in the last number of **De Bow** some interesting studies on the mixture of races in America. Dr. Callon continues (from the June number) his examination of the various routes for ship canal to the two oceans; a letter from Mr. Evelyn (author of "Cotton Culture in India," published in this Chamber) is in answer to the question whether the cotton plant of the South; and a quantity of information on various national subjects, reprinted from Reports and Communications of the Chamber, but which is very interesting throughout, except where the Southern's mischievous valour is called forth.

The **Egg-plant, several New Strawberries, the Gladiolus, the Marigold, the Impatiens,** and many other plants, are seasonably treated by the contributors to the August Journal of Horticulture, and Prof. Henderson makes a summary of the most important results of his researches in the culture of the **"Geranium a Pelargonium."** A great quantity of advice and information is swept up by the editor in a series of articles on "Fruit-culture," "Notes on Fertilizers," and "Fruit-pollination." There is no other agricultural magazine quite so bright, companionable and up to the age as the Journal of Tilton & Co.

The most attractive parts in the August number of the **Journal of Tilton & Co.** are a translated article on early life of a martyr in America, and a plea for the convocation of a universal Synod of Jews at some future date, for the purpose of settling the difficulties introduced into Jewry by the march of modern ideas. The other articles are of exclusively Hebrew interest, and are of excellent quality.

The second number of the new religious periodical, **Good News**, has a fair variety of moral and pleasant reading without sectarianism. There is a very pleasant and thoughtful article in the article entitled "Literary Characteristics of the Times." The paper contains some of the most interesting and valuable material of the kind in our literature.

Dr. Fyfe's New Chastity, a physician's physician, who assisted at the birth of Queen Victoria, has put together the ingredients of a medicine in a little book called "Advice to a Wife." From this advice any woman may gather some previous idea as to the care of her health. The manual is very interesting and contains what has passed through eight rapid editions, and we know of no similar work which contains so much practical and useful information in its style of plain, unobscured conversation. The decorum of such a book is its directness. Dr. Cassaree not only calls a spade a spade, but he is straightforward and candid as a school teacher.
