

TELEGRAPHIC SUMMARY.

Sixty buildings at San Francisco, Cal., were destroyed on Sept. 27. Loss \$75,000,000. Two hundred and fifty patents will be issued for the week ending October 1.

Four miners were crushed to death last Thursday, by the falling of a shaft of the iron mine at Mount Hope, Morris county, New Jersey.

Secretary Schuyler has issued an order suspending the sale of government arms, ammunition, etc., for the present.

A fire in Buffalo, yesterday, destroyed the Commercial Advertiser newspaper office, and the contents of several business firms. The total loss is \$200,000.

Three ex-convicts were arrested at Helena, Ark., on Sunday night. A man who served under him was arrested for the crime of murder.

On Saturday night in Kent County, Va., Mrs. Stewart was murdered, and her body committed to her house, which was also burned.

A train on the Virginia Central Railroad, with two hundred men of the Twenty-ninth Regiment on board, ran off the track near Gordonsville, Va., yesterday.

Lee Morrison, a negro desperado, was lynched near Helena, Arkansas, on Saturday. Morrison murdered several persons last winter; he also killed one of the Sheriff's posse that attempted to arrest him on Saturday, and severely wounded two others.

Jesse L. Williams, of Indiana; Brent Major, of Ohio; and J. B. Bledsoe, of Ohio, have been appointed Commissioners to examine the road and telegraph lines of the Union Pacific Railroad, under the direction of the Secretary of War.

A railroad tunnel in Ohio, which had been burning for some days, was on Monday, burying two men. While an engine was backing up to the scene of the disaster, it ran into two handcars, containing 18 men, 5 of whom were killed, and 3 seriously injured.

At Helena, Arkansas, on Saturday, a deputy sheriff attempted to arrest a negro who had committed several murders. The negro fled, killing the deputy and wounding several others, then escaped to the woods. Being soon after captured, the negro was lynched.

In the Georgia Senate, yesterday, the bill declaring negroes ineligible to office was reported in the affirmative. The bill provides for a distinction in public conveyances on account of color. A bill was passed prohibiting military organizations.
