PHILADELPHIA MEDICAL AND SURGICAL SCHOOLS.—We present, to-day, a full list of the schools and institutions of the city of Philadelphia where medicine and surgery, or any of their branches, are taught, showing the great facilities open to all who desire to study in that line.

The University of Pennsylvania was chartered 1763, and is situated on Ninth street, above Chestnut street.

The Jefferson Medical College was chartered 1838, and is situated in Tenth street, between Chestnut and Walnut streets.

The Philadelphia University of Medicine and Surgery was chartered 1854, and is located on Ninth street, below Locust.

The Women's Medical College, established and chartered some 18 or 20 years ago, is located on North College avenue, west of Nineteenth street.

The Philadelphia Homoeopathic Medical College, also named the College of Physicians, is on Filbert street, above Eleventh street.

The Jayne Street Medical Institute, Jayne street, Ninth above Chestnut.

At the Philadelphia Hospital (Almshouse), Blockley, West Philadelphia; the Pennsylvania Hospital, Chestnut street, above Locust.

The Philadelphia School of Anatomy is located in Chestnut street, Tenth above Chestnut.

Clinical lectures, illustrated by patients, anatomical and microscopical preparations, drawings, &c., with courses on practical ophthalmology, otology and surgical operations are given at the Wills Hospital for the Blind.
