Cultivation of Rice.

RICE is cultivated very extensively in warm countries, and is used by more people as an article of food than any other cereal, except wheat.

About two-thirds of the inhabitants of warm countries live almost exclusively on rice, and its nutritive strength is greatly in excess of most other kinds of grain.

Rice is frequently sent to market without being hulled; but when properly prepared for food the grain is both clean and assorted.

Rice is cultivated very extensively in South Carolina, and other Southern States. The finest Carolina is said to be the best variety in the world.

Watering Newly Set Trees.

A great mistake is sometimes made by drenching the roots of newly set trees, when they do not start to grow as soon as the owner desires.
