Foreign Items.

A Terrible Earthquake.

On January 16th an earthquake destroyed the city of Schemacha, in Russia. According to the official report 118 persons were killed and forty-four wounded, but all the inhabitants were left without shelter. Schemacha is or rather was, a city of 25,000 inhabitants, and lies on the road between Tiflis and Baku, at the foot of the Caucasian mountains about seventy-five miles distant from the latter city. Schemacha is 2,316 feet above the Caspian and 2,360 above the Black sea, and was formerly the seat of government of the province, which, however, on account of the frequent earthquakes in the region, was transferred, about ten years ago, to Baku, on the Caspian sea. The inhabitants of Schemacha are nearly all Armeanians.

A special dispatch from Paris to the Standard says a number of prominent Russians are now in that city negotiating with , Polish refugees there for their return to their native country. The dispatch says the negotiations look to a reconcillation between the Czar and the disaffected Poles, general amnesty for all past offenses and the appointment of the Grand Duke Alexis to be Viceroy o Poland.

On the 29th ult., a tremendous land slide occurred, on the line of the Panto Railroad, South America, moving from its foundations and burrying the road for a long distance under earth and rocks. It is believed that it would take two months work to restore the road to working order.

13 It is stated that the French Government is negotiating with the government at Berlin with a view of anticipating the full payment of the war indemnity, and thereby securing the complete evacuation of the French territory by the German troops.

A Terrible Affair.

An awful tragedy was lately enacted a few miles from Dayton Ohio. A German named Leonard Morquant murdered his wife and three children. His wife was found lying on the bedstead naked, choked to death. About 200 yards from the house, and close by a small stream, was found the youngest child, an infant, with its head smashed. A short distance further up the stream were found the other two children, a boy and a girl, aged six and eight years, stark naked, but with no marks upon them. They were evidently drowned and their bodies aftewards taken out of the stream and laid on the bank. Morquant was arrested and is now in jail. It is thought he must be insane.

The history of the affair, which the man, himself tells, is that a few days ago he read a chapter, to his family, from the Bible, and then rising, accused his wife of being a witch and using witchcraft, and that his eldest daug'tter confirmed him in the ac-

He says on Saturday night he told his wife he wanted the children to leave that, and he had his wife stripped naked, and and knelt down and prayed for fifteen minutes. They then stripped the two children, and took them out and drowned then, and laid them side by side on the bank stream. They then dashed out the brains of the infant and left it lying in the woods, after which he returned bome and went to bed, after lying there fifteen minutes he told his wife he wanted to send her to Heaven, and immediately strangled her to death. After that he rose and prayed until three o'clock in the morning, when he went to the nearest neighbor and told the whole story. Marquant is a German farmer, and has been in the country "bout eighteen years. The murdered woman was his second wife.

A Narrow Escape.

The Hartford Times says: A singular occurrence is told us concerning a man at the powder mills. Of course the utmost precautions are used by the employeeswooden shoes, and no smoking or matches allowed on the premises. This man, it seems, had been smoking; going into an apartment where there were a large number of open barrels of powder-it is said 100-waiting to be headed, and sat down on the edge of one of them for a few minutes, when he was suddenly called out to see a visitor. Arriving outside the door, he discovered that his coat was on fire! He had tucked his pipe into his pocket before entering the powder mill, and had not, as he thought he had, extinguished the fire. A moment more, and there might have been such a powder-mill explosion as Connecticut has not witnessed.

A. W. Anderson, watch maker and jeweler, of Bedford, went to New York to lay in a stock of goods. He got into a street ear, which was crowded, and before proceeding far, the car collided wth a twohorse team, throwing the standing passengers down, and in falling Mr. A's pocket book flew out. He picked it up, placed it in his pocket, and when he returned to his hotel, he found that he was minus twentyfour hundred dollars-all the money he had. All efforts to recover the money were of no avail.
