Variation In Cabbages.

A writer in the "Journal of Horticulture" (English) says:

"Any one at all conversant with cabbages is well aware of how they sport and vary. Go into the market gardens, see in a ten-acre field if you cannot pick out nearly as many distinct cabbages as you will find in a collection of thirty or more named sorts, not including the rubbish, from one of the London seed houses. The market gardener has only one stock of seed saved with the utmost care from his very best samples, and yet the plants exhibit all this great variety-some early, some late, some small, some large. This liability to variation is greatly influenced by seasons; sow from the same bag of seed the following year, and not half the variation will be seen. This is how new cabbages, at least new names for cabbages are manufactured. Seed is saved from these accidental variations, and named Jones' early, Smith's champion, or Robinson's superfine, as the case may be, and for a season or so some of their peculiarities may be retained. The reputed varieties of cabbage are far too numerous, and the distinctions far too trifling. How very annoying it is, in endeavoring to keep up our supply of cabbages throughout the season, to find, after having ordered ten or twelve sorts of 'lates' and 'earlies,' that from one packet of the true market the same results could have been obtained.

"In 1862 a trial of sixty-one named sorts of cabbages was made in the Royal Horticultural Society's garden, Chiswick, and as the report states, the committee only found five distinct; no less than twenty-eight of them being synonyms or more or less impure stocks of the London market, Fulham or Battersea. In this, the year 1872, the report has pretty much the same application; many of the same names, indeed, are still advertised."

Powdered Coal for Unhealthy Plants.

In a communication, the writer states that he purchased a very fine rose-bush, full of buds, and, after awaiting their maturing, was greatly disappointed, when this took place, to find the flowers small, insignificant in appearance, and of a dull faded, color. Incited by the suggestion of a friend, he then tried the experiment of filling in the top of the pot around the bush, to the depth of half an inch, with finely pulverized stone-coal. In the course of a few days he was astonished at seeing the roses assume a beautiful red hue, as brilliant and lively as he could desire.

He tried the same experiment upon a pot of petunias, and soon after all the pale and indefinite colored ones became of a bright red or lilae, and the white petunias were variegated with beautiful red stripes. Some of the lilac petunias became a fine dark blue. Other flowers experienced similar alterations; those of a yellow color alone remained insensible to the influence of the coal.

Keep the Kitchen Air Pure.

A little sink near a kitchen door-step, inadvertently formed, has been known, although not exceeding in its dimensions a single square foot, to spread sickness through a whole household. Hence, every thing of the kind should be studious obviated, so that there should be no spot about a farm-house which can receive and held standing water, whether it be the pure rain from the sky, the contents of a wash-basin, the slop-bowl or the water-pail.

Freckles indicate an excess of iron in the blood, we are told, the sun acting on the particles in the skin as it does on indelible ink, bringing out the color. A very simple way of removing them is said to be as follows :

Take finely powdered nitre, (saltpetre), and apply it to the freckles by the finger moistened with water and dipped in the powder. When perfectly done and judiciously repeated, it will remove them effectually and without trouble.

A writer advises owners of plum trees to suspend in each, just after blossoming, several corn cobs which have been thoroughly soaked in sweetened water. He says that the curculio insects prefer these to the young fruit, and deposit their eggs in them. They must be taken down and burned when the fruit ripens, by which all the young insects will be destroyed.

To Drive Rats Away.

Fill the rat-holes with new-slaked lime; repeat it a second time if necessary. It affects them in such a manner that they soon leave, very seldom requiring a repetition of the dose.
