FARM AND HOUSEHOLD ITEMS


## Hints to Farmers． <br> In screwing nuts into any part of ma－ elhinery，in cold weather，be careful thiey do not contract after being screwed on tight not contract after being screwed and become immovablo aftewards． In plowing or teaming on the road in hot weather，always rest the horses on an em－ tnense， inence，whore on a warn valley． <br> In setting out young orchards，always registor the varieties immediately in a book， where they thay bo referred to in a fow years，when the trees commence bearing， and the lables are lost and name forgotten． In laying a garden for fruits and vegeta Bles，phace everything in drills or row， that they that they can be cultivated by a horss， thus save the expenso of hand labor． If beets are harvested properly，in good dry weather，they will not bo ilkely to re－ tain much carth，especinlly if the soll is thin much earth，especially if the soil is light．Otherwise，pains must be taken to lonock the carth offin Paint all tools exposed to the weather， and if with a light－ocored paint they will not heat warp or crack int Dip well－seasoned shingles in a lime wash，and dry them before laying，and they will hast much 1 covered with moss． <br> Always tie a halter by first making singlo loop，and thrusting the end of thi latiter through this loop．This is quickl untied，and will never come untied Itself． Dip the ends of nails into grease，and they will drive easily into hard wood wher they ohurwise double and break．

 If dew fell，it would fall for the samereason that rain falls ；but tow fall，it is simply a deposit of molsture，a
ways contained in the air to a groator lesser degree，and which，when thero is
enough of it，will always form on any cold the same way that a cold bottle or stonc， taken from a cold cellar，and suddenly ex－
posed in the shade to the moist，warm sum mer air，will become wet；this is not sweat－
ing，nor does this moisture come out of the botte or stone，as many poople believe but
from the air．It is for the same reason window－panes，when the air is cold out－ freezing，while its deposits form crystals of ice，which we so often admire in winter．
When the weather is cool enough， moisture deposited will even freeze on frost ：if it doesnot freeze it is simply dew， The only point left to be explained is，why does the ground become so cool during the
night，so much cooler than the air above it as to causo the latter to doposit its mois－ problem，till Wells first suggested tie radi－ ation of obscure heat，which takes place
from the surface of the earth through the clear atmosphore into the space above，snd
so causes the surface to become much cool－ er than the air itself．Ho demonstrated this by means of thermomoters placed at
difforent heighte，and also by the fact nights，When there are elouds，they reflect the heat，or preventit from escaping．The
surfice of the earth thus being lopt from cooling，no dew is deposited．－Manuface－
turer and Bulder．
