Variety of Food．
In an experiment detailed in Deits＇s Farm
Journal，where hogs were fed on cooked potatoes and oats，the excrement slowed by the anodine test（whioh is very delicate）
that a large portion of starch was passing off undigested．Tho addition of a smal
mount of peas to the feed caused all 4 starch to be appropriated to the animal that a variety of food is essential to the perfect development of animals．When
hogs are fed for auy length of time on the ame food，they become＂glatted，＂and to their accustomed diet canses a marked improvement．If they are fed on corn，
they should have pumpkins or potatoes， and access to grass abould be allowed them
when they do not have a variety of food
