Keep Ammonia in the House.

No housekeeper should be without a bottle of spirits of ammonia, for, besides its medicinal value, it is invaluable for household purposes. It is nearly as useful as soap, and its cheapness brings it within the reach of all.

For washing mirrors and windows it is very desirable, put a few drops of ammonia upon a piece of newspaper and you will readily take off every spot or finger mark on the glass.
