

and have a soft layer of sawdust or chopped straw beneath the hens. Soft eges are indicative of an excited condition of the ovary from over feeding, at least when plenty of lime is given. Reduce the feed, and give only oats, and no meat, cooked feed, or pepper for a week or two.

Holding up the Milk.

We have found the most effective plan to get the milk down when a cow is inclined to with-hold it, is to treat the cow gently and give her a pail of bran, shop, or some feed more than ordinarly entiting to her appetite. A handful of salt given to the cow at such a time often helps to bring the milk.

Buckwheat bran when fed to cows will produce a large quantity of milk, but promptly filled. the milk will be as thin as water and of a bluish color. Meal of peas, wheat and corn will make the richest milk and of a yellow color. Meal of peas and wheat bran will make excellent feed.

Car An English farmer, in examining lately an unpainted larch gate put up more than twenty years ago, found it in a very surviceable state without repair. A neighbor put up at the same time a larch and an oaken gate-post, and found the larch post lasted the longest.

Car Chestnuts can be preserved any length of time by simply putting them in a bag or box, and sprinkling common salt among them. The salt not only keeps the worms from them, but prevents them from becoming hard.
