The cow is a cross between the Durham and our common breed, about 8 years old and a little above the medium size. PHILADELPHIA, July 5.—There is more demand for Wheat from the local millers, who purchase chiefly of prime lots; sales of 2,000 bushels prime Penna. red at \$1.45, 1,500 bushels do. at \$1.45, 1,400 bushels do. on private terms, 400 bushels fair Indiana do. at \$1.40, 400 bushels Maryland do. at \$1.45, and 1,400 bushels good Delaware do. at \$1.45. Corn full, but we continue former quotations; sales of 2,000 bushels Pennsylvania yellow at \$1.09, 2,000 bushels Western do. at \$1.06, and some Western mixed at \$1.05. Rye is unchanged; 500 bushels Pennsylvania sold at \$1.09. Oats are quiet but steady; 2,000 bushels good and prime Pennsylvania were taken at \$2@63c.
