THE STATE CAPITAL.

COMING ORGANIZATION OF THE SENATE AND HOUSE.—Percentage of reductions in the personnel of the Legislature—Work for the Winter.

There are already many visible, unmistakable signs of a more than ordinary struggle now in progress for the organization of both branches of the Legislature.

The point of interest to which all eyes are now attracted is the organization of the Senate.

What is known as the measure to authorize a use of the bonds and other resources in the sinking fund to pay the railroad bonds of the State will be received, modified, the securities increased, all proper grounds considered, and then, as is consistently practiced, passed.

For Speaker of the House there are now three prominent Republican candidates, namely, James H. Webb, of Bradford county; Bitter B. Stragg, of Tioga county; and J. McKean, of Venango county.

Another important measure for consideration of the Legislature of 1871 is the State apportionment.
