THE CHAMOIS. This animal which belongs to the Alps and Pyrenees, and is found in flocks from four to eighty, and even a hundred. It is about the size of a domestic goat, of a dusky, yellow brown color, with the cheeks, chin, throat and belly of a yellowish white.

When alarmed, the Chamois hisses with such force that the rocks and forests re-echo, the note being very sharp at first, and becoming deeper toward the close. Having passed a moment, the animal looks round, and perceives his apprehensions to be well founded, he again hisses with increased violence, at the same time striking the ground with his fore feet bounding from rock to rock, and evincing the utmost agitation, till the alarm is spread to a very considerable distance, and the whole flock provide for their safety by a precipitate flight.

Their agility is wonderful, as they will throw themselves down, across a rock, which is nearly perpendicular, and twenty or thirty feet in height, without a single prop to support their feet.
