The Chicago Tribune, of Oct. 19th,
has the following:
WHAT IS SPARED U.
Our columns have been so extensively occupied during the past week with reports of the enormous losses of life and property in the late fire that there is some danger that the damage sustained will be over-estimated. True, we have seen 2,500 acres in the most central portion of the city swept bare, 20,000 buildings destroyed, and 100,000 persons rendered homeless, the total pecuniary loss being not less than three hundred million dollars; but we have still a great deal left. We may roughly estimate the situation as follows:

"About 50,000 persons have left the city population remaining, 280,000.
"Five grain elevators were burned with 1,600,000 bushels of grain; leaving us with eleven grain warehouses intact, containing 5,000,000 bushels.
"One-half of our stocks of pork products were burned up, with the same proportion of flour.
"Of lumber, 50,000,000 feet were burned; the stock remaining is 240,000,000 feet.
"Of coal, 80,000 tons were burned up; we have 70,000 tons on hand.
"Our stock of leather was decreased one quarter, the whole value of that burned up being \$95,000.
"The greater portion of the stocks groceries, dry goods and boots and shoes were burned up, with more than one-half the ready made clothing; but the quantities destroyed were scarcely equal to a three weeks' supply, and are now being rapidly replaced.

Not more than ten per cent of the currency was destroyed by the fire; we have 30,000 houses left standing, and our real estate could not burn up.
"A very careful average of these larger items, with smaller ones that need not be enumerated, shows that the city of Chicago has suffered a loss of not less than 20, nor more than 25 per cent, on her total assets—real and personal. The loss is a great one; but, so far from irreparable, that we may confidently hope to see a return to former prosperity ere long.
The ratio of increase during the past thirty four years has averaged 104 per cent. per annum. This rate would restore the status of a month ago within three years. Making every due allowance for the terrible set back experienced, there can be no doubt that five years hence, at most, the exhibit of population, wealth, commerce, and manufactures will be greater than a month ago. Already the city is rising from its ashes at a rapid rate, thanks to the large-hearted liberality of our countrymen everywhere, and the resistless energy of our citizens. Let the faint-hearted ones take courage; the real workers have not wavered a moment in regret; after they have repaired their losses there will be no occasion for it.

"The papers of the Eastern cities are publishing personal experiences of persons professing to have been sufferers by the fire in this city. These stories are for the most part fabrications. The descriptions given of the murders and rapes by bullies, thieves and ruffians, during the progress of the fire, are wretched inventions.
"A respectable New York paper gives room to a long recital of the narrow escape of 200 abandoned women from their lodgings in Reynolds's Block. The pictures of obscenity and profanity are drawn by an expert but are wholly destitute of truth. No woman of that, or any other class, occupied rooms in that block. The fire was horrible enough in all its details; there was a full share of its selfishness and heartlessness peculiar to human nature; there were frequent cases of drunkenness and indifference to the impending calamity, but there was no general brutality, fondness, nor crime. The thousand stories of incendiarism and crime during the progress of the fire are gross exaggerations, perversions or pure fabrications. There was little time for stealing; the fire was too close upon the heels of honest men and thieves, and but little even of what was stolen could be carried off.
"The news of the fire brought hither thousands of thieves from other cities; but these did not reach here until Wednesday and Thursday, and by that time public vigilance had been aroused, and their stay was short and unprofitable. The suffering of our people was terrible enough; it needs no exaggeration to make it the most extensive scene of human misery; but for the credit of common humanity we desire to stamp these stories of murder and other less atrocious crimes as false in every particular.
