

Meeting A Sheriff with Scalding Water and Shot Guns

On Thursday morning May 9th, Sheriff Myers, accompanied by Deputy Sheriff Hess and Frank Musselman, visited the premises of a family named Barclay, residing near Dry Wells, in Colerain township, to dispose of a property sold at sheriff's sale, and confirmed by the court to H. R. Swarr, Esq., in January last. The sheriff found the house locked, the inmates being Sarah and Martha Barkley, and their mother, aged seventy-eight, and a man named Miller. The demand for admittance was refused, and the party threw hot water through the opening. Frank Musselman entered, upset the boiler containing hot water and put out the fire. The inmates, being armed with clubs and hatchets, retreated up stairs awaiting that they would not surrender alive. The old lady furnished a double barrel gun, loaded and capped, and dared any one to come up stairs. Sheriff Myers took the gun from her, uncappped it and put it away. The party prevailed with the sheriff, begging him to leave and report that he was unable to dispossess them. Finally the sheriff and his party succeeded in dispossessing the occupants and putting their goods out. Possession was then given to Wm. Campbell, to whom Mr. Swarr had rented the property. The party said they had been advised by a lawyer to resist.— Lancaster Examiner.

A Fowl Obstruction.

A late number of the Des Moines (Iowa) Register says: "A singular case of railroad obstruction, and one for which no remedy is provided by the statutes, occurred a few evenings since on the Valley road in Green county. Conductor Livingston's train, when about three miles this side of Grand Junction, in a pond, ran into an immense flock of swan, brand, geese, and other wild fowls. The birds were just about to alight on the track as the train drew near. Their number was so great that the sky was filled with them, and those above pressing down on the lower strata, forced them to alight on the cars. The engine, tender and cars were covered with the fowls, and some even clung to the bars of the cow catcher. One stately swan had a wing injured in the crash, and found a resting-place on the head light, from whence he was taken by the engineer. The bird, however, managed to escape from custody near Perry, and jumping from the tender where he had been tied disappeared in the grass. The raid continued several minutes, quite a number of the aerial army being run over by the train, and some half dozen being captured by passenger and train men. As soon as the birds on the top of the flock began to understand the situation they soared away, followed by the entire company. Livingston says it was the biggest crowd of dead-heads that ever tried to board his train."

How to Learn Languages.

A writer on the modern languages in American Colleges in the June Galaxy, deprecates any course of instruction which does away with either the study of the ancient or of the modern languages. But he reverses the traditional order, and advises the pupil to take up at the age of ten or at all events, not later than twelve, one modern language, and pursue it at all stages of life. Then the other, he thinks, should be added, not at the age of fifteen, as the student should begin Latin at sixteen. Greek, he says: "No one, however, should be allowed to pass over to Latin who has not first mastered thoroughly the principles of the two preceding languages. During the year after 15, while the stress is and must be had upon Latin and Greek, the pupil should preserve and extend his acquisitions in French and German by careful reading on alternate days. Such a curriculum, if faithfully and persistently carried out, will give him at the end of his 18th year—the average age of entrance in our older colleges—all the linguistic training that he needs for deriving the fullest benefit from his college course. He will have had three years' preparation in Latin and two in Greek, after which, he will have had, already been trained to linguistic study, and will have had a continuous, progressive preparation of six and four and a half years respectively in the two great living languages of Europe. The result, too, will have been effected without encroachment upon the time necessary for mathematical and other studies. The proposed curriculum would require the following number of hours: from 12 to 134, four hours per week for German; from 135 to 154, eight for German and French; from 155 to 164 for Latin and four for German and French."

There is a general movement in the vicinity of New York city among workingmen for a reduction of hours of labor to eight hours a day. The carpenters have succeeded in securing the reduction. The same movement has extended more or less to other trades, especially the masons and bricklayers. The New York Tribune publishes a table showing that there has been at once an increase in wages and a diminution of expenses for food and fuel since 1869, making the aggregate increase in wages very large.

An Indiana farmer, after trying to trap, poison and shoot the rats that overrun his premises, bought two goats and gave them the range of yard and stables. Within a week every rat exterminated and stayed away until the goats were sold, nearly two years after, when they all came back with all their friends. A second edition of rats was procured, and since then not a rat has been seen on the premises.
