The War of Extirmination.

Now that the main body of the Modocs have been captured, the question is, will we do with them? While hostilities continued, it was understood that the President intended a war of extermination, that he wanted the tribe wiped out. We do not know on what this understanding rested, as the President certainly never so expressed himself publicly or officially. He is too good a soldier to indulge in such declarations, and too discreet a civil officer to give vent to such violent language. The Modocs are savages and war from their stand point and apprehension of armed hostility. During their conflict with the national authority, they committed no act which can be regarded as more fiendish or barbarous than those which were the daily transactions of the man who led and directed the slaveholder's rebellion while it lasted. Capt. Jack with Gen. Canby's blood on his hands, is no more ruthless or treacherous an enemy than Jeff. Davis proved himself, as the leader of treason. Where Capt. Jack murdered one gallant officer in cold blood, Jeff Davis sanctioned the murder of thousands of Union prisoners, and was cognizant and gave authority for the assassination of hundreds of defenceless Union men in the South. Under the Constitution, Davis could neither be tried for treason nor for murder, and we hold that the construction of that instrument which screened the arch traitor must also protect Capt. Jack and his surviving warriors. We have no more legal right to exterminate the Modocs than we have to kill off the Ku-Klux who are taken prisoners in the South. Capt. Jack and his warriors are no worse than Jeff. Davis and his followers. The Modoc warrior is no bloodier enemy of the government than the Confederate still clinging to the lost cause. If the one is to be exterminated, the principle of peace or war which sanctions it, also applies to the other. The government dare not deny this, and any course of brutality towards the savage warriors now our prisoners, will humiliate us at home, and hurt us among the civilized nations of the world.—State Journal.

WASHINGTON, June 10.—Information reaches here to-day from London that the Government of Great Britain has made an arrangement through the bank of England with certain bankers to deliver to the Secretary of State in Washington, on or before the 15th of September, fifteen and one-half millions of dollars in gold—the amount awarded by the General Tribunal to the United States. From the same source it has been learned that the money will probably be delivered on the 10th of September, three days before the expiration of the time provided for in the Treaty of Washington. As soon as the money is paid over, the Secretary of State will, in pursuance of an act of Congress, passed at the last session, invest the money in 5 per cent bonds, which will be held subject to further legislation.

WASHINGTON, June 15.—It was ascertained from the Secretary of the Navy, to-day, that the Junata will proceed to Disco and Uppernavik in about one week from this date. Her commander will be particularly instructed to inquire at those places, and of the Esquimaux along shore, concerning the Polar, and whether she has been heard from during last winter and spring. In the meantime the Department will fit out another vessel to leave the United States about the 19th of July to search for the Polar, should her safety be not reported before that time. The expedition will be amply provided with such means relieving the necessities of the officers and crew of the Polar, as circumstances may require. It will be strictly naval in its character, and sent to perform a specific duty.

A few of them were recognized by friends and privately buried, but the great majority remained unidentified. Many of the dead were children, a few were old men, but the mass were composed of the mature and strong of both sexes. In a single week the bodies of twelve infants were found beneath the docks. This is a terrible exhibit of one city, and that not the largest of the Empire State.

A series of experiments will be made the coming autumn to ascertain, if possible, the cause of steam boiler explosions. So far the nature of some explosions remain a mystery, in spite of all the researches of experts. The experiments will be conducted under the authority of Congress, one hundred thousand dollars having been appropriated for the purpose and the President requested to cause the necessary investigations to be made. Either Pittsburg or Cincinnati will be chosen as the centre of the western field of inquiry and Sandy Hook for the eastern. The boilers tested will be such as are commonly used in the respective sections, and it is said the Pennsylvania Central Railroad Company has offered to present those used for the western experiments.

Two commissioners for each section are to be appointed and these are to make all the preparations, after which the most prominent experts, mechanical engineers, and scientists in the country will be invited to be present and assist in the examinations. The result of these experiments will be looked forward to with great interest, and it is to be hoped some more definite information may be obtained as to the explosive properties of steam and the collective power of iron under sudden and

A New Trial for Stokes. ALBANY, June 10.—The Court of Appeals, by a unanimous opinion, has granted a new trial to E. S. Stokes for the murder of Fisk. When Stokes was informed of the decision of the Court of Appeals, granting him a new trial, he expressed himself well pleased, but added quickly and somewhat sadly, that the report might possibly be untrue, and the disappointment would be all the greater if such proves to be the case. His counsel, relatives and friends soon arrived at the tomb, and there was a good deal of rejoicing among those interested at the favorable decision of the appellate court. Counsel say that upon the next trial they will prove to the satisfaction of the New York public that there has been gross misapprehension of the case from the day of the tragedy, and they will be able to establish the fact of his innocence by evidence of an overwhelming character.

McEnery, the leader of the rebel faction in Louisiana, has advised his followers to submit quietly to the Kellogg government until December, when an appeal will be made to Congress for settlement of the questions which have provoked conflict between the two parties. If McEnery had adopted this course from the first, it is not unlikely that he would have commanded the respect and support of a good many persons who now regard him with any but friendly feelings. But he can have no credit for adopting a policy of peace at this particular juncture. Any further demonstration on the part of his adherents will provoke the interference of the federal government, and acceptance of the situation is therefore a necessity. What the action of the rebel faction would be, if such intervention was not expected, may be conjectured when we recall the lawlessness and crime which have marked its progress in this contest. There will be no more butcheries such as that which occurred in the town of Colfax, and no more assassination and resistance to the execution of the laws, because the Louisiana outlaws are coward, and not because they are converted to decency and righteousness. And if Congress does not give the political condition of the State consideration, as assuredly it ought to do, the record of this faction should suffice to bar forever its claim to any portion of the authority to which it aspires. The most corrupt and detestable Republican government that can be organized in the State would be far preferable to the government conducted by the villains who strove to plunge the people into the horrors of civil
