Pennsylvania Items.

—One thousand black bass are reported to have been put in the dam at Williamsport by the fish commissioners.

—The Lewisburg shoe factory, which has been standing idle for some months, was destroyed by fire on Thursday Aug. 21. Loss about \$7000—insured.

—Dr. Hurlburt, of Lewistown, was attacked week before last by four highwaymen in the river bridge at that place, who demanded his money. He knocked one down when they all fled.

—A horrible case of cruelty has come to light in Philadelphia. A young girl was confined in a filthy den by her stepmother for six months, kept in starving condition all that time amidst filth almost endurable. The police have arrested the stepmother.

—The contract for the erection of a new court house, in Millintown, Juniata county, has been awarded to Messrs. Hetrick & Fleisher, of Newport, for the sum of \$42,300, the County Commissioners to furnish the brick. The bids ranged from that figure up to \$95,000.

—John Beck and Jesse Robinson of Marysville, while hunting in the woods near that place, discovered a skeleton of a child lying upon the ground. It was afterwards recognized by a piece of dress covering the object as the daughter of Mrs. Crounce, who was lost about two years since.

—George Lyon, of Susquehanna tp., Juniata county, has in his possession a pig four weeks old, which was born with but one fore leg. There is no shoulder on the left side and nothing visible excepting a piece of flesh upon which there is a nail like that upon the finger of a human being.

—The veterans of the Pennsylvania Volunteers are preparing for a grand time at their reunion on the 17th of September at Philadelphia. It will be the eleventh anniversary of the battle of Antietam.

—If the new constitution is adopted, all county officers will thereafter be paid salaries instead of fees. This will, we presume, be a satisfactory arrangement to all concerned.

—By an act of Assembly, applying to all portions of the State, cruelty to animals is made punishable by law. The act provides for the punishment of any person who shall wantonly or cruelly ill-treat, overload, beat, or otherwise abuse any animal, whether belonging to himself or another.

—An affair arising out of a dispute about some land, occurred at Julian Furnace, Centre county, on Friday, the 15th ult., between two men, Hard Richards and John Williams, which will no doubt prove fatal to the latter. Richards struck Williams in the head with an axe, causing a wound from which the brain oozes, and it is thought he will die from the effects.

—In Moyamensing prison, Philadelphia, are two men, one of whom has not seen the light of the sun for twenty-three years, and the other for ten years, and over both during this time have hung sentences of death. When these men were convicted their cases that mitigated their crimes and restrained the lunatic & just Governors of the period from signing their death warrants.

—Judge Dean, at the recent term of the Blair county Court, in sentencing the Tyrone druggists for selling liquor without license, took occasion to remark substantially as follows: "Druggists are authorized to sell liquor for medical purposes, subject, however, to the risk of indictment. A physician's prescription is not of itself a safeguard for the druggist. If the latter, even on the prescription of a regular physician, sells liquor to persons of known intemperate habits, or to those who are known to use liquor as a beverage, he is liable to indictment and if found guilty, he will be punished to the extent of the law. In short, in the opinion of the court, a druggist who sells liquor for any purpose whatever, or upon the prescription of the most eminent physician in the country, does so at his own risk."

SAN FRANCISCO, Aug. 29.—A heavy shock of earthquake was felt at Mission San Jose at 4 o'clock this afternoon, causing excitement, but doing no damage. The shock was quite heavy at Redwood City and other towns south, but very slight in San Francisco.

General News.

—A Georgia plantation which sold for \$30,000 in 1860, brought \$500 at a sheriff's sale recently.

—A river 800 feet under ground was lately struck by a mining shaft at Ploche, Nev.

—An old minister of ninety, who lives near Spencer, Owen county, has eleven sons who are ministers.

—"Did your wife have any income last year?" inquired a revenue assessor in Ohio. "Yes, sir," replied the assessed; "both girls."

—The Christians observe Sunday, the Greeks Monday, the Persians Tuesday, the Assyrians Wednesday, the Turks Saturday, Catholics Friday and Sunday.

—Judge Thomas A. B. Nelson, late judge of the United States Supreme Court, died at his residence at Knoxville, at six o'clock of the 24th ultimo, of cholera, after an illness of two days.

—Charles Nordhoff, who has been looking into the question of Chinese labor on the Pacific coast, says he doesn't believe there are a hundred "decent men, who work for a living," engaged in the present crusade against the Chinese.

—In Tennessee, recently, a white outlaw went to a colored man's house in his absence, and after compelling the little children to take out and pile up the scanty furniture of their home in the yard, he set fire to it and consumed it. The family Bible survived the other articles.

—The New York Financial Chronicle expresses the opinion that money will be easy, and that the fall trade of the metropolis will be good. This anticipation, it says, is giving an active impulse to various new enterprises, especially those of rail-roads, which are reviving after long depression.

—Six German beer-sellers of Worcester, Mass., have been fined \$101 each and sentenced to six months imprisonment to the House of Correction for violating the very stringent law of the State. They were fined, in addition, to give bonds of \$1,000 each not to violate it again for a year.

—It is said that Cornelius Vanderbilt offered Horace F. Clark, few weeks before the latter's death, \$1,000,000, cash down if he would lead a healthful life, go to bed and get up early, and eat simply and regularly. He told his son-in-law he could not just unless he mended his habits. Vanderbilt's prediction was verified much sooner than he had expected.

—A family festival of rare occurrence recently took place in Fischelton, Canton Zurich, when M. Knecht District Judge, and his wife celebrated their diamond wedding. A singular circumstance connected with the affair was that the pastor who joined the young couple sixty years before was present on the occasion. All three are still robust, and enjoy the best of health.

—Professor Wise, it is stated, will start on his balloon voyage across the Atlantic on the 10th of September. As we heartily wish the experiment to be successful we shall prophesy no evil, albeit we confess to entertaining grave doubts of a happy issue to what strikes us as the wildest project that could enter the brain of man supposed to be sane.

—Judge Emerson, of Salt Lake City, has sustained the defendant's demurrer in the case of Anne E. Young vs. Brigham Young, for divorce, against the jurisdiction of the District Court. The judge held that the Probate Court and not the District Court had jurisdiction in the case. This is the direct opposition to the opinions of Judges McKean and Howley, and virtually of the Supreme Court of the Territory. The case again comes up before Judge McKean at the October term of the District Court.

—The Granges of Minnesota, several of which have already appointed delegations to attend independent political conventions, are ordered by their Grand Master to annul this action. He instructs them that the rules of the Grange forbid any political movements by its members, acting as such. As individuals, however, they are free to act as they think proper. This order will not interfere with the success of the Conventions, as the farmers will send delegations appointed by public meetings instead of the Granges.

—The London Builder gives the following dimensions of a bridge to be constructed over the Frith of Forth: "The structure will be by far the largest bridge in the world. It will be 150 feet in height, and will contain nearly 100 spans. The greatest span in the centre will be 1550 feet in width, or nearly a third of a mile in extent, dimensions which are without a parallel for any similar piece of architectural construction, and the smaller openings or spans will be 150 feet in width, being considerably beyond the average dimensions of the largest spans in ordinary bridges. It will cost at least ten millions of dollars."

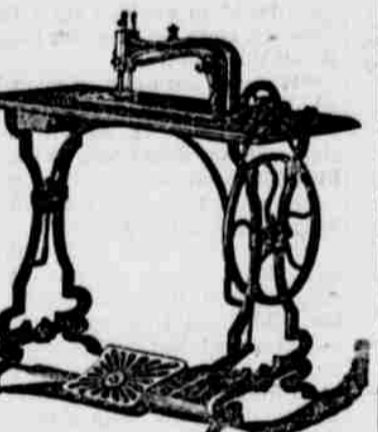
