Great Fire at Selingsrove. LOSS FULLY \$160,000.

About 6 o'clock, Friday evening, 30th prox., Selingsrove was again visited by a terrific conflagration far more destructive than the fire of Feb. 25, 1872. It was undoubtedly the work of an incendiary and no more propitious time for complete destruction could have been selected as a strong wind prevailed. The fire originated in the stable of George Schure, Esq., which had been fired on several occasions before. Some forty-five or fifty buildings were destroyed, in the very heart of the town, including the Keystone and National Hotels, Methodist Church, Times Printing office. Neither Brick nor Stone were impregnable against the fire. The Susquehanna Fire Company of Selingsrove, the North River and Hook & Ladder Company of Sunbury by the most super-human efforts succeeded in subduing the flames about 9 o'clock, but for whose efforts but little would remain of Selingsrove.
