The Nickel Mine.
 The little mine used as a
 smelting medium are nearly all
 from material mined in the
 mining country of Lancaster,
 where in yielding about 6,000
 tons a year. The mine is
 about 100 feet deep. The
 mine has been sunk about 200
 yards westward of the main one,
 and is being opened up
 through a solid body of
 ore, being opened up by
 a tunnel below. Eleven shafts
 now been sunk ranging from
 140 feet in depth, and are
 being worked by means of
 steam power. The mine is
 in constant use, two at a
 time, and at the smelting works,
 from 25 to over 100 horse power
 pumps throw over two
 feet of water at each stroke. A
