Representative Enclerth, of Daugherty county, has introduced a bill in the House providing for the infliction of a fine of \$200 on any person who attempts to represent by representing the holders of age. The bill also provides for an imprisonment of the offender, not exceeding three months, if the court should deem such action necessary.

The Legislature last winter, by an act approved March 31, 1876, fixed the date for the annual meeting of the Auditors of the several townships and boroughs to settle accounts on the second Monday in April. It was formerly fixed on the first Monday in June. These accounts are required by law to be published under a severe penalty for neglect.

Distemper in the Cows.—Dr. Cheney, of Boston, announces that hypodermic of soda furnishes a sure specific remedy against distemper. He uses it in his own practice, and reports more than one hundred and fifty cases of successful treatment. A dose of the hypodermic is from five to fifteen grains or more in a single injection, and is repeated every two or three hours, according to the age and circumstances of the patient. Fasting is the only evil which an overdose can produce, hence as much as the patient can bear, producing that result is a good rule in the severe cases. The solution or mixture can be used in doses of five drops to half a drachm in milk. For thorough stimulation the amount is greater than can be taken in water. Dr. Cheney usually gives the specific in milk, using usually the good taken in milk, using usually the good taken in milk. It is said, however, that hypodermic prevents the digestion of milk, and therefore the latter should not be given in less than one hour after administering the medicine.

The following is also said to be a certain cure, and if so, is within the reach of all: Take ordinary garden sage, make a strong tea, put it in an ordinary tea pot and let the patient inhale the steam through the nostrils. By this process relief is soon obtained, and a short time the patient is restored to health. So say those who have given it a trial.

Capital Letter. HARRISBURG, Mar. 9, 1877.

The past has been a week of not very active but nevertheless of important legislation. Most of the Republican members took advantage of the Sunday recess to visit Washington and participate in the inauguration of President Hayes. Returning to the session of Tuesday morning the business was at once entered upon rapidly and among the most important legislation the appropriation bills take the precedence and they are being pushed through with all possible speed.

FINAL ADJUSTMENT. A joint resolution has been passed by both houses fixing Friday March 23rd, as the end of this session and providing for a regular adjourned session to be held next year. It was provided that as soon as a day of adjournment had been determined upon that all billstingering would be dispensed with and the work of legislation would progress without interruption and this is the disposition of the republican side of the house, but the democrats seem to have adopted the policy of retarding business as much as possible, and the liberal rules of the house puts it in the power of even the minority to call the yeas and nays upon every trifling proposal and introduce motions and resolutions of a frivolous character in order to prevent the regular proceedings.

The object on the part of the democrats is to prevent as much work as possible and then arrange the majority in the next campaign for doing nothing and thus try to bring the republican legislature in as great odium as that of the previous two years.

NEW TAX BILL. This bill passed the House finally after a bitter fight this week and it is one of the most important general bills that will be brought before the legislature. The system of taxing corporations for state purposes heretofore has been to levy a tax upon dividends or net profits. In consequence of the crisis the dividends have been so reduced that this important source of revenue to the state has almost entirely failed. The House will take the bill and Reading Railroad company which formerly paid into the state treasury about \$100,000 but last year only returned \$35,000 and its return next year was simply nominal. The state tax upon land having been taken out of some years ago it was evident that we should have to return to the old tax or devise some other means of securing money from corporations and so this bill was introduced by Mr. Hahn, of Philadelphia.

These are both important bills. The former as originally drawn provided the penalty for future entire principal and interest for the taking of any such bill finally passed on Wednesday after striking out the forfeiture of principal features and in this shape it may succeed in its final passage on third reading though the prospect is not very flattering. The new company bill has not yet reached its second reading and, in consequence of the limited time of the present session and the amount of opposition to it, there is no probability that it will be passed into a law. If it would not be killed, it will come to a vote. The local option bill will probably fall for this session for the same reason. The opposition will filibuster by discussion and the introduction of dilatory amendments until it is too late for action.
