**False Economy**

There is no class of people to whom the true saying "Get the best" has a more direct and striking application than that which is engaged in agricultural pursuits. It is false economy that prompts a farmer to use implements which are not adapted to his work, simply because they are cheap. It is a false economy which prompts him to maintain an unsound horse, or winter a cow who will not produce a profit on the food she consumes, in the milk he sends to market. It is a false economy to feed a flock of sheep that do not possess the constitutional capacity to produce heavy fleeces of valuable wool, lay on flesh if needed for mutton, with fair keeping, or bring farm lambs that will fetch a good price when the green peas come to market in the spring. It is false economy to feed the long-haired razor backed swine, when there are so many improved breeds from which to select, and which will convert a bushel of corn or other food into good mercantile pork in half the time that their shabby relations or ignoble blood can do it. We do not think that farmers as a class are more conservative than people engaged in other vocations, but we know that there are some in almost every community who hesitate to avail themselves of the improvements which have been invented by human ingenuity for their advantages in recent years; and a few who still adhere to the ways of their fathers, and continue to rear the old red native stock of the country, when the means for improving them all about them, by crossing with the best breeds of foreign stock which their more liberal-minded and enterprising neighbors have introduced among them — *Mas. Houghman.*

**Salt in the Garden.**

A correspondent of the *Country Gentleman* who has been experimenting with salt, says: Gardens should be salted very liberally, for by so doing you will have no worms, maggots, onions, club-rooted cabbages, or any other vegetable growth in it injured by worms, grubs or any vermin that infest the soil. Every one who raises asparagus knows the necessity of using salt abundantly. One can scarcely use too much. Many who grow cabbages know its value when applied to the roots or growing onions may be buried under salt, leaving only the tops out, and that the onion will grow thrifly while all maggots and worms will die or disappear — *such is the fact.* Salt mixed with wood-ashes, in the proportion of one of salt to four of ashes, applied at the rate of a handful to the centre of each hill of corn immediately after planting, will supersede the use of scarcerows and col-tar, as no worm or crow will touch it, besides giving the fertilizing properties of the compound. A friend residing in Ebensburg, Otsego county, who had broken up four acres of swart upon which to plant corn, found it to be so very wormy that he dared not plant it until I gave him the above recipe, which he used after plowing. In the fall he told me that, although this lot had worms upon three sides of it, he did not lose a single hill by worm or crow. This fact is worth remembering.

**Use of Buttermilk.**

Bathe the face in buttermilk, sour of course; it is not quite agreeable we know. Take a soft rag and dip into the buttermilk and wash every part of the face, neck and hands. If there has been a greater exposure to the sun than usual, after washing the face well, squeeze out the cloth and just wipe the skin off, and let it remain so without washing till morning, you will be astonished how soon the fresh sunburn will disappear.

For keeping the hands and skin soft there is nothing equal to buttermilk. When you get burned with the hot sun one or two batheings in buttermilk will cause the burning to cease, take out the inflammation and render it comfortable quicker than any other remedy tried.

There is something in the acid contained in the buttermilk that does the work.

When one has staled fingers, either with berries, apples or nuts, it will remove the stain almost immediately.

It is particularly cooling to the skin.

You will never try any other lotion for beautifying the complexion, after using the buttermilk, if you can obtain it.

Then add one pound of sweet flavored butter, which will soften the candy, and mix it until it is again hardens and pour into trays, cover with sugar if desired.
