If the Democratic platform is not ironed in its "free ballot" declarations, the Republicans will carry a number of the southern states at the coming election; but possibly the southern representatives of the Democracy will interpret the declaration to mean free ballots as far as depositing them is concerned, but subject to their peculiar counting processes afterwards.

Who Now is on the Defensive?

What has become of that dash, aggressive Democratic address and that feeble, halting, defensive Republican campaign? We heard a great deal about them only a little while ago.

There will be no child's play when the drums beat for action, and the Republican party will give another evidence to the world that the rights of man for which they have no intention of surrendering in the council the privileges which they purchased with their blood.
