

Good Law.

The following law, relative to trespass and destroying fruit and ornamental trees, etc., was enacted at the late session of the Legislature, and has been signed by the Governor.

An act to protect fruit and punish trespass in this Commonwealth. Sec. 1. Be it enacted, etc. That the willful malicious taking and carrying away of fruit, vegetables, plants, fruits, or ornamental shrubs, vines or shrubs, in any orchard, garden, yard, field, or enclosure, or in any other place, shall be deemed a trespass, and the person so offending shall be liable to a fine of not less than ten dollars, nor more than fifty dollars, for each offence.
