

RESOLUTION Proposing Amendments to the Constitution of the Commonwealth. Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met: That the following amendments be proposed to the Constitution of the Commonwealth in accordance with the provisions of the tenth article thereof.

Nays—Messrs. Coffey, Gregg, Harris and Penrose—4.
