

RESOLUTION Proposing Amendments to the Constitution of the Commonwealth. Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, that the following amendments be proposed to the Constitution of the Commonwealth, in accordance with the provisions of the tenth article thereof.

So the question was determined in the affirmative. On the question, Will the Senate agree to the third amendment? The yeas and nays were taken, and were as follows: Yeas—Messrs. Brewer, Brown, Coffey, Crosswell, Ely, Evans, Fleuniken, Ingram, Jordan, Killinger, Knox, Laubach, Lewis, Meyer, Seiffel, Sellers, Shuman, Southern, Steele, Straub, Welch, Wilkins and Wright—25. Nays—Messrs. Coffey, Gregg, Harris and Penrose—4.
